Terms and Conditions for eligibility for the GDFM co-payment scheme

1. The GDFM co-payment scheme is only applicable to non-trainee MOs who are serving their bond within the clusters with less than 6 years of graduation from medical school.
2. Retrospective inclusion in the scheme will not be allowed.
3. The additional \$2,000 training funds will only be reimbursed to each GDFM trainee upon completion of the GDFM exams. GDFM trainees are therefore required to agree at the start of the course to fulfill all training requirements and sit for all the exams.
4. Doctors who sign up for GDFM from 2008 to 2010 and sit for their GDFM no later than 2012 will be able to obtain the reimbursement for their GDFM course fee through CFPS.
5. Reimbursement will be provided upon proof of having attempted the GDFM exams and will be regardless of the exam results.
6. No bond will be imposed on doctors who sign up for this scheme.
