

User Guide to access the Singapore Family Physician: MCQs

Steps:

- 1) Open the Internet Explorer
- 2) Type the web address: <http://www.cfps2online.org>
- 3) Key in your Username and Password stated on the letter
- 4) Click on 'Yes, help me log in' if you had forgotten your password.


